## 2022 MISSISSIPPI PICKLE FEST PERFORMER RULES

**APPLICATION DEADLINES:** The deadline for all applications is May 20, 2022. Performers will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

### **PARTICIPANTS:**

- Only those individuals who complete all necessary paperwork indicated on the application and receive approval by the Mississippi Pickle Fest Entertainment Committee will be allowed to perform.
- The Mississippi Pickle Fest is a family friendly event and as such all entertainers must maintain an appropriate stage presence. Cursing, obscene or graphic content, condoning of drug use or other adult themes WILL NOT be tolerated. The Mississippi Pickle Fest reserves the right to take immediate action in any situation where these rules are not followed. This action ranges from requiring a performer to discontinue that portion of their performance, to shutting down the performance all together.

### **FESTIVAL HOURS:**

- The 2022 Festival will operate from 3:00 pm to 8:00 pm on Saturday, June 11.
- You will be allowed to pack up your equipment once you have finished your performance; HOWEVER no performers will be allowed to drive into the festival area prior to the 8:00 p.m. closing time.
- Due to safety concerns, streets will remain closed to vehicle access on Saturday from 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Performers are responsible for setting up and dismantling their own equipment in the designated area during the designated time frames.

### **SETUP TIMES:**

- Saturday, June 12 from 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

You will be directed to your designated area by the Vendor Committee during these setup periods.

### **PERFORMER CHECK-IN:**

- Saturday Check In:
  - Please enter the Mississippi Agriculture and Forestry Museum grounds via the gate on Lakeland Drive.
  - Check in at the tent for your setup information.
- When you check in you will receive your performer parking pass.

### **UNLOADING:**

- Unload your vehicle at the appointed space and immediately park your vehicle in the designated lot. You may then return to your space for set up.
- Your vehicle must be out of the festival area by 2:30 p.m.
- Do not leave your vehicle parked in the street while you set up. This blocks vendors behind you who are trying to unload.
- Bring as few vehicles as possible into the festival area.

### **POWER:**

- Be sure that all electrical cords are heavy duty and equipment are in excellent condition. The Mississippi Pickle Fest reserves the right to take immediate action in any situation where equipment, including electrical appliances and extension cords, appear to be substandard or unsafe. This action ranges from requiring a performer to discontinue use of problem equipment to shutting down a performance.

### **SAFETY:**

Festival safety is critical to all of us! It is important that we all work together to have a SAFE and fun Mississippi Pickle Fest.

- Event security will be provided by the Mississippi Agriculture and Forestry Museum; however performers are responsible for securing their equipment.

### **RELEASE:**
