I am excited to announce that we will be going on a field trip to the Mississippi Agriculture and Forestry Museum!

There are three ways the Ag Museum accepts payment for chaperones:

- Chaperones pre-pay the school and receive the \$5.00 group rate. The chaperones are included in the payment from the school.
- Chaperones come to the front desk upon arrival and use cash, credit card, or debit card to pay the standard adult rate of \$6.00
- Chaperones can select one representative to pay for the entire group by collecting the money before entering the Museum campus. The \$5.00 group rate will be given if 10 or more are paying together.

If you are signed up to be a chaperone, here are a few things to remember:

- The adult chaperones assist in monitoring and maintaining behavior within the Museum and should also facilitate the learning of their group. **Please stay with your assigned group.**
- Enjoy the Museum! The Mississippi Agriculture and Forestry Museum is intended to be a fun, educational experience for all ages. When you experience the exhibits, you encourage the students in your group to learn and enjoy them as well.
- If at any time someone in our group (student or adult chaperone) needs assistance, please look for one of the Ag Museum employees.
- Please be advised that our group will be sharing the Museum with other groups and individual visitors during the visit.
- Be mindful that the exhibits on display at the Museum contain artifacts. Please remind children not to touch or climb on artifacts or exhibits on any part of the Museum grounds.
