



MUSEUM MANNERS

- Teachers and chaperones are responsible for ensuring that students/children **REPRESENT YOUR GROUP WELL**, as you will be in the Museum with other visitors.
- **HAVE FUN!** In order for each person to fully enjoy the Museum, students/children should be divided into and stay with groups of 10 or fewer led by a teacher/chaperone. (Admission policy allows one adult free for every 10 paying students)
- **EXPLORE THE MUSEUM!** We have thousands of things to do and see, but *please do not run, climb on, or touch anything* unless invited to do so by a Museum representative.
- **VISIT THE GENERAL STORE**, and feel free to get a drink and/or snack, but please remember that *no food, drink, or gum is allowed* in the Museum's Heritage Center Gallery or Fitzgerald Building.
- **BE EXCITED AND SHARE WHAT YOU SEE!** Remember to use *quiet voices* inside buildings though. Too much yelling or loud voices may result in your group being excused from the facility.
- **FIND OUR ANIMAL FRIENDS!** Students/children should be reminded that the animals should not be chased, fed, or teased, and may bite, potentially resulting in injury to the visitor and/or animal.
