1. Is there paperwork I need to do?

You will need to complete the Volunteer Packet. This includes your contact information, emergency contact information, basic volunteer guidelines, and release forms. You can find the link to this paperwork here:

2. Can I get service hours for my time?

YES! You can get service hours for your school or civic organization. Please let us know ahead of time that you will need the hours documented. We will be glad to sign off on the forms for you.

3. How old do I have to be?

We ask that volunteers be at least 16 years of age and accompanied by an adult. This is for safety reasons. We encourage families to participate together.

4. Do I need training ahead of time?

NO! We will provide training for you in the area you are interested in. For example, if you would like to be a docent in our Heritage Gallery, we will provide you with the information and training on proper ways to give a tour. HOWEVER, many of our volunteer positions don't require training, just a willingness to help make the museum a wonderful place to be.

5. Can I just volunteer for the event I'm interested in?

ABSOLUTELY!! We need volunteers year-round, but if you want to just volunteer for one event you are more than welcome to do so. As a side note, you will still need to complete the volunteer paperwork.

6. Do you have inside Volunteer stations? I can't take the heat.

We have stations both indoors and outside. You let us know what you prefer, and we will work with you!
